The purpose of this report is to document conformance with the requirements of the LegalSource standard by Bord na Móna Plc hereafter referred to as "Organisation". The report presents findings of LegalSource auditors, who have evaluated the Organisation's systems and performance against the applicable requirements. 	The Organisation should be aware that Version 2 of the LegalSource Standard will include specific requirements for LegalSource certified Organisation's to conduct an evaluation of each Certification Scheme used as part of the risk assessment. This applies to the FSC certification scheme used by the Organisation. An evaluation of this scheme (and any other certification schemes used) should be in place by the time of the next annual audit. The Organisation may utilise the new tool in the revised LegalSource due diligence system (DD-13) to conduct this assessment and should be aware of the requirements which will be used for assessment at the next audit (LS-18).

Description of Non-conformance:				
BNM collects a substantial amount of information regarding its material's supply chain and the Biomass Sustainability & Project Manager proves to be aware of the potential risks and necessary mitigation steps needed. However, the actual risk evaluation conducted is not recorded in the documents containing the supply chain information (EXH 6,7,8). Most noticeably, the endangered status of the species used in the material, the risks at country and regional level, the prevalence of armed conflicts, the potential UN or EU bans on timber exports from the supplier countries.

	This is adequate to meet the terms of the requirement but could be improved by collating all information in one document as an overview, not only of the risk assessment outcome, but also the detail of the risk assessment process. This was discussed with the Project Manager during the audit as the UK Competent Authority (CA) has highlighted the lack of well-documented risk assessments by EUTR Operators. The Project Manager agreed remarked that it may be useful to have a detailed risk assessment report for each supply chain for presentation to the Irish CA and for internal purposes. The Project Manager should review the Risk Identification Checklist Template (DD-08) in the revised LegalSource Due Diligence system for this purpose.

BNM has in place a generic companywide complaints procedure (EXH 5). This information was collected by the Biomass Sustainability & Project Manager, who however, was not aware of the added requirement in V2 of the LegalSource standard.

The existing complaint procedure does cover some basic requirements around timeframes

and responsibilities, but nothing regarding appropriate corrective actions or maintenance of records.

The Biomass Sustainability & Project Manager recognised that as part of the risk assessment, the prevalence of armed conflicts or conflict timber was not evaluated specifically. However, he was aware of the potential terrorist threats in the northern part of Cameroon and recognised that it should not impact their supply chain. A more focused evaluation on potential risks of conflict timber entering the supply chain is required to be conducted.

BNM has collected certification information from their supplier (EXH 4). The certification status was checked by the Biomass Sustainability & Project Manager, however, at the time of audit, one of the species sourced was not listed in the scope of the certificate on the FSC database. This demonstrate a gap in ensuring the information relates to the product purchased.

Description of findings leading to observation:	Bord Na Mona records and track the evolution of NCRs observed as part of its supplier verification (EXH 1). However, this is done by the Biomass Sustainability & Project Manager and not as part of a regular review or procedure.	
Observation:	For consistency, it is recommended that Bord Na Mona implements the steps already being taken as part of an annual (or more frequent) performance review already described in section 4.3 of their DD-02-LegalSource-Due-Diligence-Manual-Template-2013-11.

Description of findings leading to observation:	BNM has a clear idea of the scope of the material included in their DDS as they source a limited number of material, species and from only 2 suppliers.  However, there was no consistency between the various working documents used (EXH 6 and 7), as regards to the species included in the scope of the DDS.
