Join our accredited FSC FM online course to fulfill formal FSC Forest Management auditor training requirements whilst gaining useful insight into the FSC FM system!

This FSC FM course consists of an online content @NEPCon Training Hub, followed by a 4-day intensive live sessions Training @Zoom, covering the FSC standards and systems for Forest Management certification.

This FSC FM course is conducted in **English**. Please ensure that your language skills will allow you to fully engage in presentations, group exercises, discussions and examinations.

FSC requirements for remote auditor training

Based on the derogation FSC-DER-2020-04 published on 23 April 2020, FSC currently allows to replace in-person auditor trainings with remote courses.

NEPCon's online FSC FM course is a customised auditor training to meet the training demand during COVID-19 pandemic, considering the travel and safety restrictions, without reducing the quality of our regular in-person auditor trainings held worldwide.

The content and duration of the training will meet all the standard FSC requirements for auditor trainings and at the same time be adjusted to be presented and acquired via different virtual tools and training methods. To enable everybody to participate actively in the live sessions and group work, the maximum number of places is 12.

Obtaining an FSC Auditor Training Certificate

Conditions for successful completion of the course are following*:

- Completion of online modules at NEPCon Training Hub
- Completion of self-study webinars at NEPCon Training Hub
- Active attendance at live training sessions
- Successful completion of exam

Students must be present in 95% of live training sessions, actively engaged throughout the whole course and have participated in individual and group exercises.
